

# Nebraska Aviation Hall of Fame

## Nomination Form

### Criteria for Selection

1. The Nebraska Aviation Hall of Fame was created to preserve the memory of extraordinary aviation related contributions by citizens of the Great State of Nebraska. Many individual efforts have been made in the pioneering, growth, and development of aviation and space exploration in the State of Nebraska. These efforts must be recorded for future generations.
2. Each year, a duly appointed Selection Board may choose from public nominations, one or more individuals for induction into the Nebraska Aviation Hall of Fame.

### Nominations

1. The nominee's achievements of service in aviation may have been accomplished worldwide, nationally, or in the State of Nebraska. The Nominee must be a native born Nebraskan or have performed significant portions of their signal service to aviation-related endeavors while a resident of Nebraska. Nominations may be made by any firm, organization or individual familiar with the nominee's achievements.
2. The Selection Board shall consider all nominations submitted. The number selected each year shall be determined by the Selection Board.
3. Nominees not chosen may be reconsidered for selection the following year. Re-nominations of previous nominees may be submitted in any year.

### Format & Guidelines

1. Submit one copy of this nomination form for each nomination.
2. Nominations must include a description of the candidate's aviation achievements. A maximum of three (3) typewritten, double spaced pages and photocopies of photographs should be included. All supplemental information should be attached to this Nebraska Aviation Hall of Fame nomination form (which may be reproduced locally).
3. Each entry should include the following:
  - a. Achievements enhancing aviation.
  - b. Contributions or service to the State of Nebraska, or to the development of others in aviation, such as pilots, mechanics, educators, artists, or engineering.
  - c. Photographs.
  - d. Biography or a 200 word synopsis.

### Selection Process

1. The Hall of Fame Selection Board is composed of at least five (5) or more active members appointed by the Nebraska Aviation Hall of Fame Committee.
  - a. All board members will review each nomination 30 days prior to the meeting of the Hall of Fame Selection Board.
  - b. At the selection meeting, each nomination will be presented to the board for discussion prior to the vote.
  - c. Each nomination will then be voted upon by the board.
2. A minimum of three (3) Selection Board members will be required to be present in order to constitute a quorum.

3. The Hall of Fame Selection Board Officers will be chosen or appointed by members during the first meeting of the calendar year. (The Hall of Fame selection will take place in October of each year. Other meetings will be held as needed.) Meetings are open to the public. However, there will be no public testimony authorized on behalf of nominees. Roberts Rules of Order will apply.

### Policy

1. Persons serving on the Selection Board may not be nominated for the Nebraska Aviation Hall of Fame during their term.
2. **Nominations must be received** by the Nebraska Aviation Hall of Fame **not later than September 15<sup>th</sup>** of each year or at the discretion of the Selection Board.
